Please follow instructions completely. Only typed abstracts will be accepted. Electronic submission is preferred. Type each abstract on a separate page, not to exceed one double-spaced page, in 12 pt. type. Abstract should include the following: title, author's name(s) (list the presenting author, who will also be the contact person, first), and a clear, concise summary of the presentation. DO NOT include an introduction, literature reviews, historical data, references, or a bibliography. DO NOT include degrees, professional titles/ appointments or addresses as part of the abstract. Submit the abstract and a biography of the presenting author (70 words or less) with this form for each presentation. Speakers' guidelines will be sent upon acceptance of the abstract. Presenters are responsible for their own conference registration, travel, and related expenses.
